In 2014, Michael A. Hammer and I co-founded the *At Ease* program to help first responders deal with the issues that come from the stressors of working in trauma-based professions. First responders are on the frontlines responding to difficult circumstances every day, and what we don't see is how these events impact their well-being and mental health. Working in fields that deal with trauma has caused some to turn to isolation, substance abuse and even suicide, as their way of dealing with Post Traumatic Stress (PTS).

The **good news** is – we are helping to Keep our first responders strong, and it is a priviledge, through confidential counseling that is free to our first responders and their families. I would like to share an example of a testimonial that we have recently received to share the impact this program has on our first responders:

I would like to offer my sincere thanks to this organization for providing me with an excellent counselor. My counselor contacted me within 24 hours of me requesting help from At Ease and set up a online meeting. From the start, I felt comfortable with her and have been meeting with her weekly for 5 months, when I completed my sessions! I never knew that I had underlying, complex PTSD issues after being a firefighter/fire officer the last 32 years. She was able to uncover these things while being extremely encouraging and competent. I am unable to describe how great she has been and made such a positive difference in my life. This experience has been one of the most difficult times I had to endure, and at the same time the most important and beneficial 5 months of my life. I would like to thank you for providing her, as well as the financial component, to get me through this. I would like to express my gratitude for my counselor and her professionalism and unwavering support, I will miss her and cannot recommend her enough for others.
